A harmonic **OR** melodic minor two octaves - separate bows and slurred in fours

F Lydian mode two octaves - separate bows and pizzicato

Arpeggios

E major two octaves - separate bows and slurred in threes

F# major two octaves - separate bows and slurred in threes

Ab major two octaves - separate bows and slurred in threes

E minor two octaves - separate bows and slurred in threes

Chromatic scale

on G two octaves - separate bows and slurred in fours

Dominant 7th
