

Scales J = 56 Arpeggios triplet J = 80








A harmonic minor scale (only 1 version harmonic or melodic required)


(Aural Tests)


Test 1 - Singing back notes.

I shall play a 2 note chord, and then you shall sing back the upper note. We shall do this with 4 different chords.



Test 2 - Clapping back rhythms.

Test 3 - Singing back melodic phrases.

I shall play a melodic phrase **twice**, and then you shall sing it back. We shall do this for 3 different melodies.
